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SUMMARY: Assist with the planning, design, permitting, and construction of Company facilities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Coordinate the planning, application, design, and construction of new customer service lines.
- 2. Review active construction projects to ensure that specifications, plans, procedures, and permits are being followed.
- 3. Assist in the preparation of permit applications, reports, etc.
- 4. Conduct hydrant flow tests.
- 5. Maintain, organize, and archive data regarding company assets (drawings, specifications, etc.)
- 6. Gather field data using various equipment, including global positioning system (GPS) collection units.
- Coordinate responses to external requests for mapping data (PA One Call, governmental agencies, etc.)
