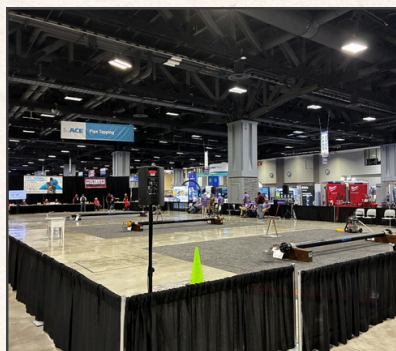

Main Extension at Reservoir Park

An existing 12" valve was also replaced during this project to allow M&G to perform necessary repairs and maintenance within the Southern Repump booster station. 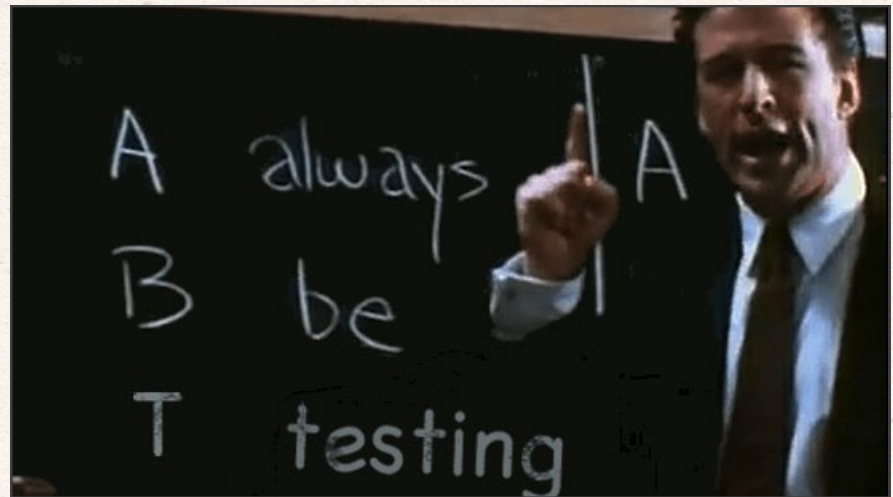

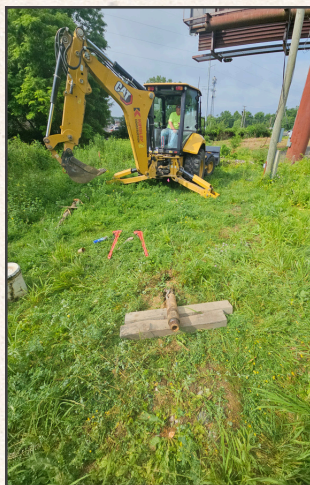
Hot Weather Safety Tips
