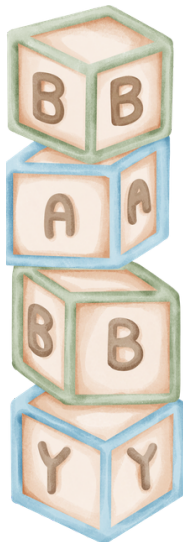

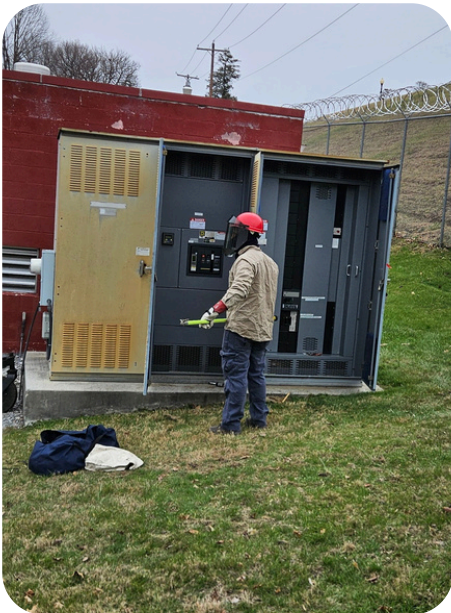

MOP & GLOW

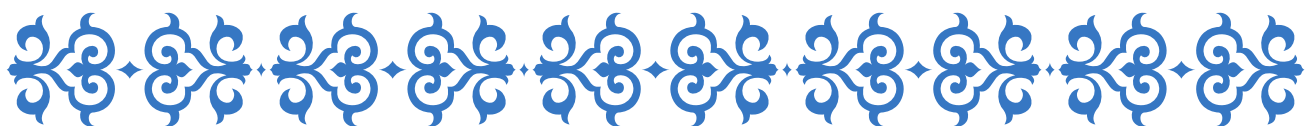
The "Mop and Glow" is a preventive maintenance procedure in which a qualified contractor is brought into our primary high-voltage facilities—including the Filter Plant, Brillhart, and the Lake Redman Pumping Station—to service electrical equipment. This work includes cleaning electrical panels using approved methods, tightening electrical connections, inspecting wiring and cables, and returning the equipment to service.

This preventive maintenance is essential to extending the life of our electrical systems and significantly reducing the risk of a major or catastrophic electrical failure. All smaller facilities and electrical panels are maintained annually by our in-house electrician, Mike McDaniel, who Jesse Hartman describes as "the hero!"



NEW BOARD ROOM GAVEL

Nick Schaefer recently crafted a new gavel for our Board Room from a historic wooden pipe. It symbolizes our 200+ year legacy and shows how every action moves York Water forward.
