Effluent Irrigation at Chanceford Crossing Wastewater Treatment Plant

The effluent irrigation system at the Chanceford Crossing Wastewater Treatment Plant is a unique and innovative operation within York Water’s wastewater facilities. The spray irrigation system features 72 spray heads that distribute treated effluent across approximately 15 acres of hay fields and wooded terrain. The irrigated Timothy Hay crop is then harvested by a local farmer, creating a beneficial reuse partnership that supports both environmental stewardship and the local agricultural community. Notably, Chanceford Crossing is the only York Water, wastewater treatment plant that utilizes land application of effluent, making it a distinctive part of York Water’s operations.

Codorus Creek Crossing Under West Market Street

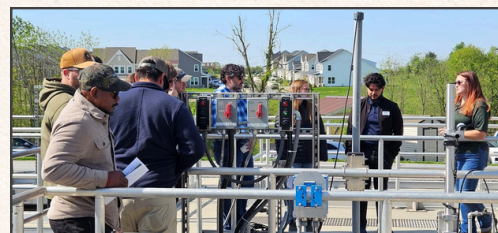
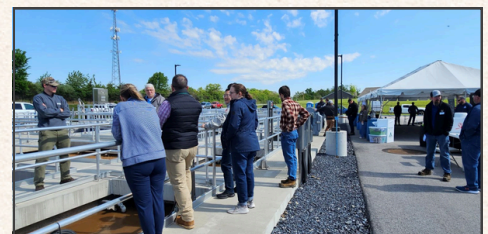
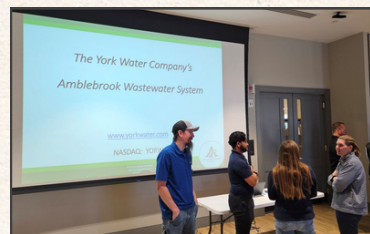
This investigation involved locating a 12-inch water main crossing beneath West Market Street within the Codorus Creek area. This was a result of a drilling rig damaging our water main.

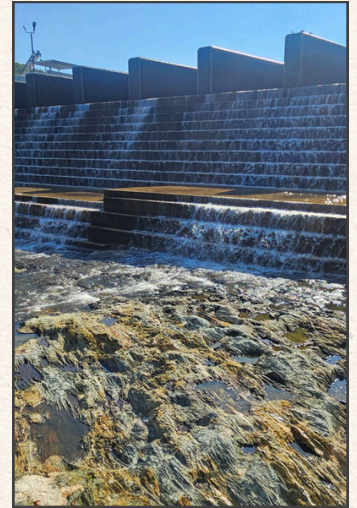
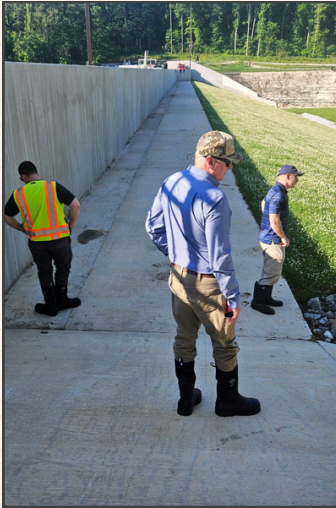
A Tour of the Amblebrook Wastewater Facilities

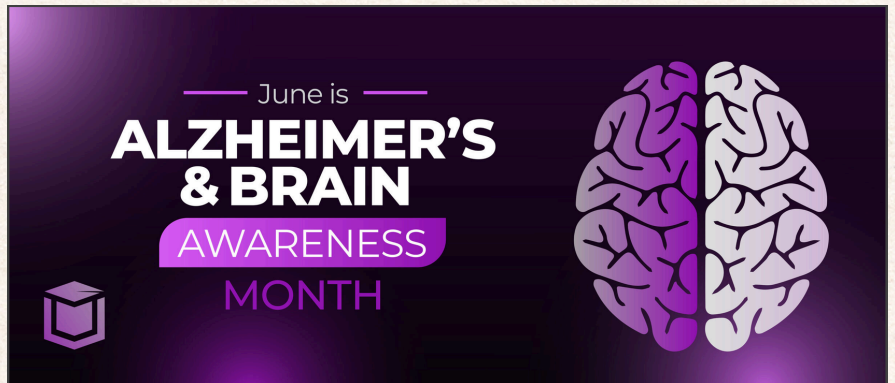
